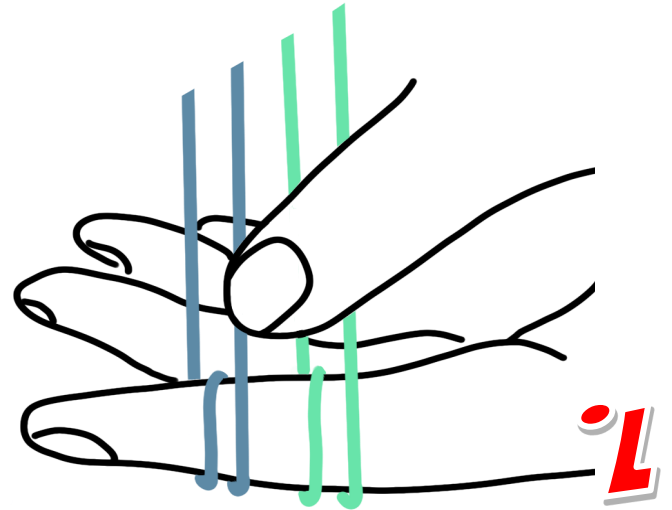
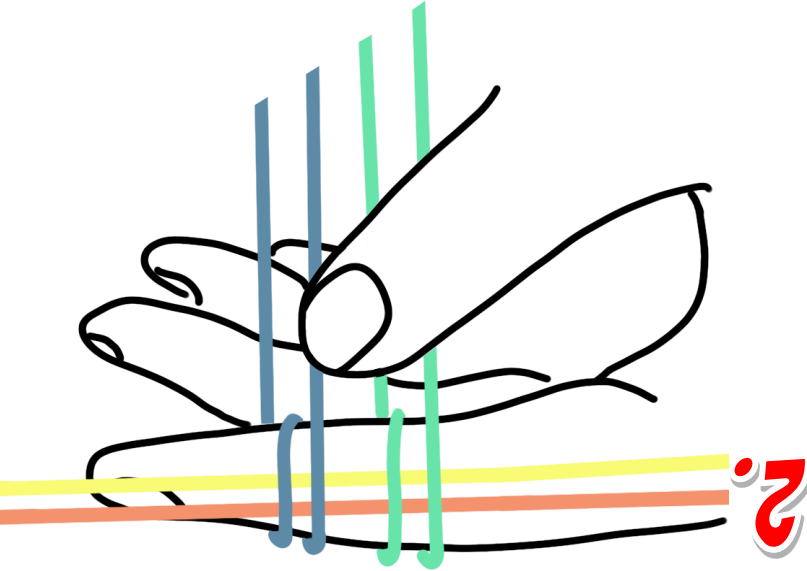


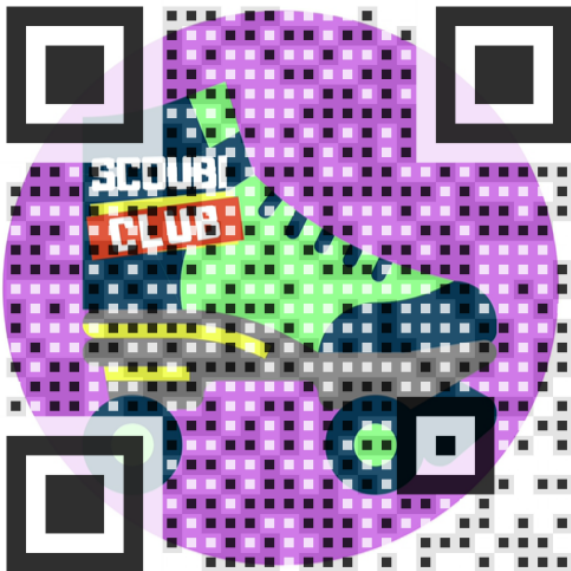
Find the middle of one strand of scoubi and wrap it around your finger as shown above. The tails of the strand should be about the same length. Match up the ends to be sure you have found the middle. Repeat this process with a second strand of scoubi. If done correctly, you should have created four loops around your finger as shown above.



Feed two more strands of scoubi under the four loops that you created in step 1. The center of the two strands should be under the loops. Again, match the ends to be sure that the strands are approximately centered under the loops.

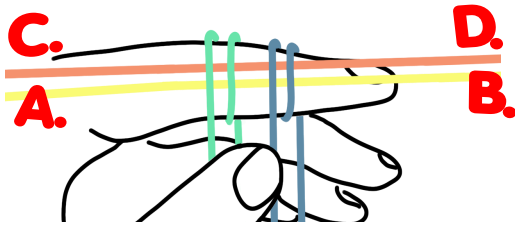

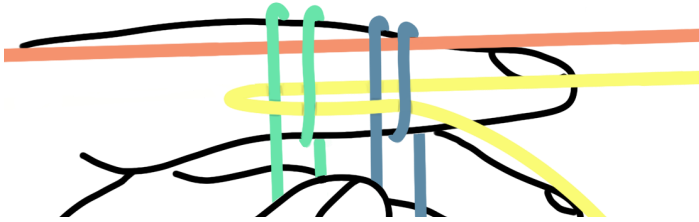

To make the first stitch, the scoubi strands must be woven in the order shown below, beginning with strand "A."



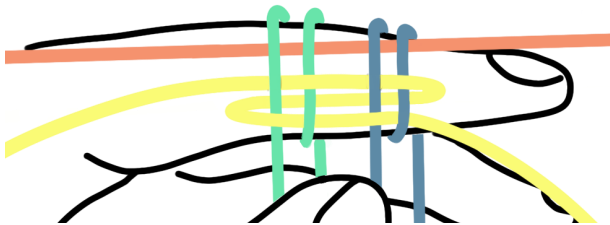
A.

Weave strand "A" towards the right, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.



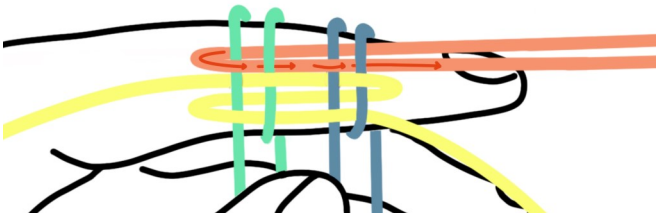
B.

Weave strand "B" towards the left, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.



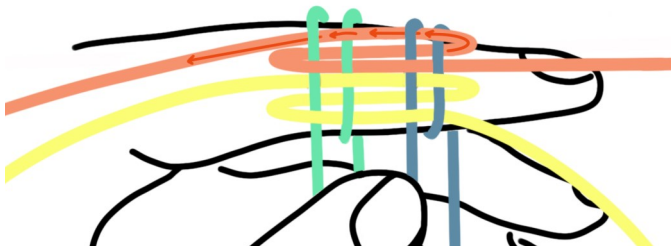
C.

Weave strand "C" towards the right, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.

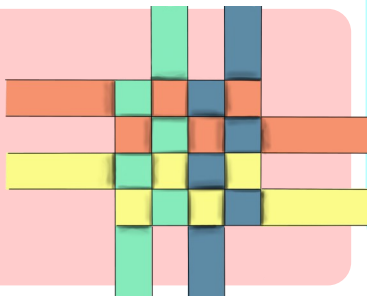


D.

Weave strand "D" towards the left, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.



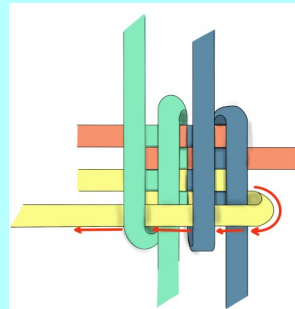
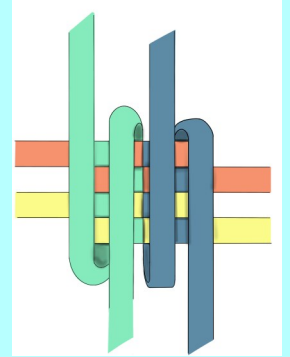
Carefully remove your finger and gently pull on the scoubi tails until you see the checkerboard pattern as shown to the right.

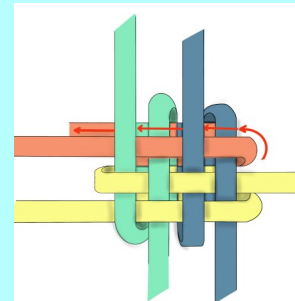
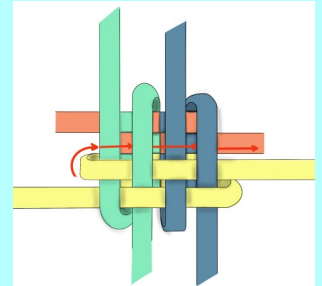
MAKING THE STITCH

Start with the checkerboard pattern facing you. Make four loops by flipping each strand over the project towards the opposite side and aligning the strand with itself.



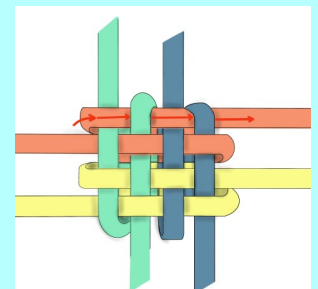
Start with the strand at the bottom right-hand corner of the project and weave it towards the left, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.

Weave the next strand towards the right, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.



Weave the next strand towards the left, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.

Weave the last strand towards the right, over the first loop, under the second, over the third loop and under the fourth.



Finish the project by tying an overhand knot in all of the strands or feeding them through the center of the project as is done with the box stitch.
