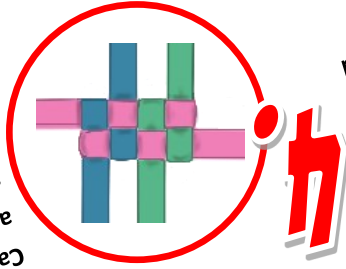
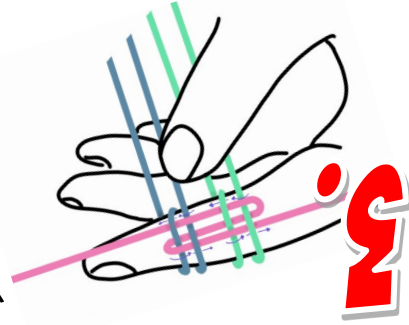


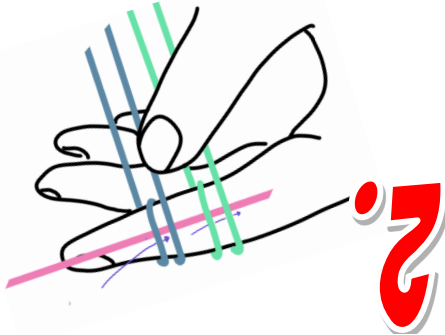
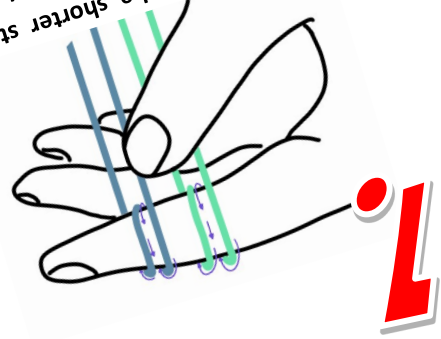
TIP: Be sure to have one of each color in each hand when tightening.
Carefully remove your finger and gently pull on the scoubi strands until you see the checkerboard pattern.



Weave the left end of the long strand OVER the first loop and UNDER the second loop then OVER the third loop and UNDER the fourth loop. Weave the right end of the long strand OVER the first loop and UNDER the second loop then OVER the third loop and UNDER the fourth loop.



Wrap one of the shorter strands of scoubi around your finger at about the middle of the strand. Repeat with a second shorter strand.



Feed the long strand of scoubi under all four loops until the middle of the long strand is under the four loops.

***NOTE THIS KIT COMES WITH 2-3 STRANDS OF THE SAME LENGTH AND ANOTHER LONGER STRAND**

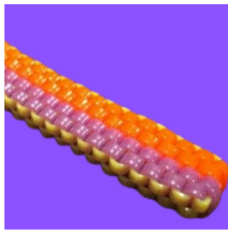

FINISHING YOUR SCOUBI

Finish the Brick Stitch and Super Brick Stitch as you do the Square Stitch, by wrapping each strand around the closest one of the same color and pulling it through the center of the project.

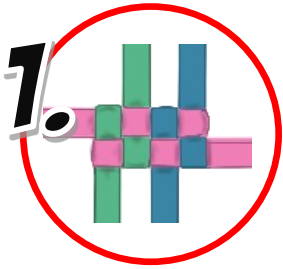

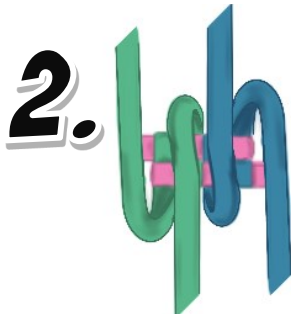


THE BRICK STITCH

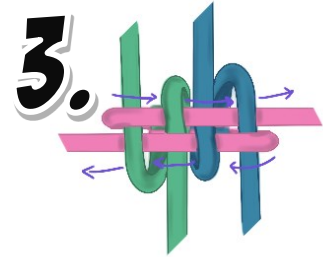
Also called the "Double Box Stitch"



Start by holding your project with the checkerboard pattern facing you.



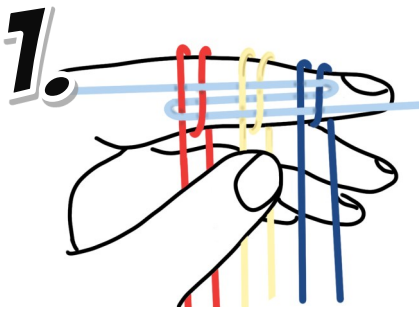
Starting with the green strand, flip the left end away from you to the opposite side of the project and then flip the right strand towards you. Repeat with the blue strand.



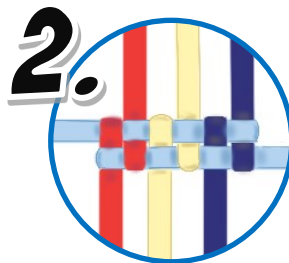
Weave the right end of the pink (long) strand OVER the first loop and UNDER the second loop and OVER the third loop and UNDER the fourth loop. Repeat this process with left end of the pink strand in the opposite direction.

**PULL GENTLY UNTIL YOU SEE THE DOUBLE CHECKERBOARD PATTERN.
REPEAT THE STEPS UNTIL YOUR SCOUBI IS THE DESIRED LENGTH!**

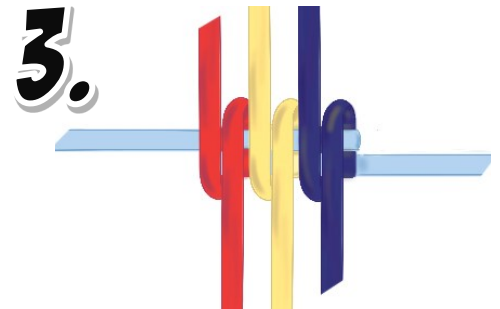
THE SUPER BRICK STITCH



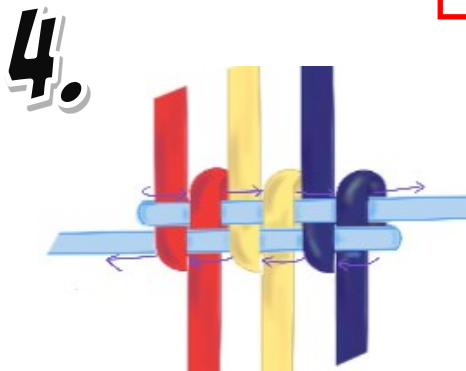
Start the Super Brick Stitch just like the Brick Stitch, but add one more short stand before weaving the longer strand.



Start by holding your project with the checkerboard pattern facing you.



Starting with the red strand, flip the left end away from you to the opposite side of the project and then flip the right strand towards you. Repeat with the yellow strand and then the blue.



Weave the right end of the light blue (long) strand OVER the first loop and UNDER the second loop, OVER the third loop and UNDER the fourth loop, OVER the fifth loop and UNDER the sixth. Repeat this process with left end of the light blue strand.
