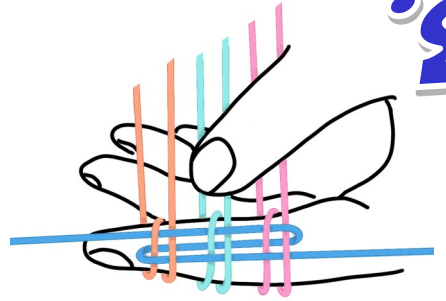
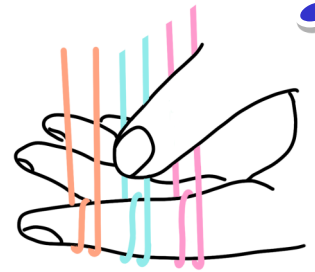

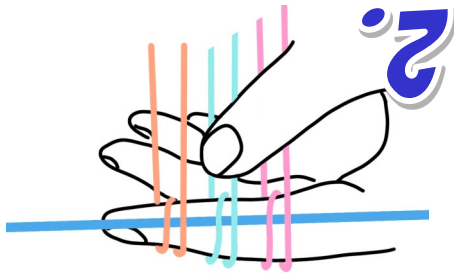
Weave the left end of the long strand OVER the first loop and UNDER the second loop then OVER the third loop and UNDER the fourth loop then OVER the fifth loop and UNDER the sixth loop. Repeat the pattern with the right end of the long strand of scoubi.

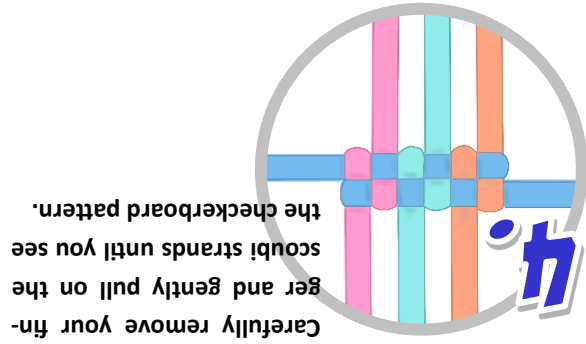


Wrap one of the shorter strands of scoubi around your finger at about the middle of the strand. Repeat with a second and third shorter strands.

2.



Feed the long strand of scoubi under all six loops until the middle of the long strand is under the six loops.



Carefully remove your finger and gently pull on the scoubi strands until you see the checkerboard pattern.

**NOTE THIS KIT COMES WITH 3 STRANDS OF THE SAME LENGTH AND ANOTHER LONGER STRAND*

FINISHING YOUR SCOUBI

Finish the Corkscrew Stitch as you do the Square Stitch, by wrapping each strand around the closest one of the same color and pulling it through the center of the project.

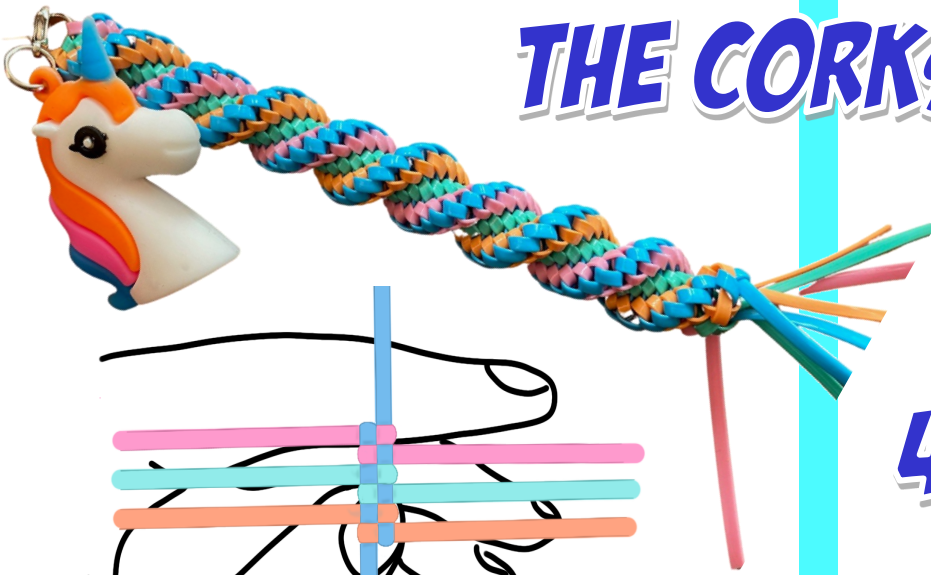

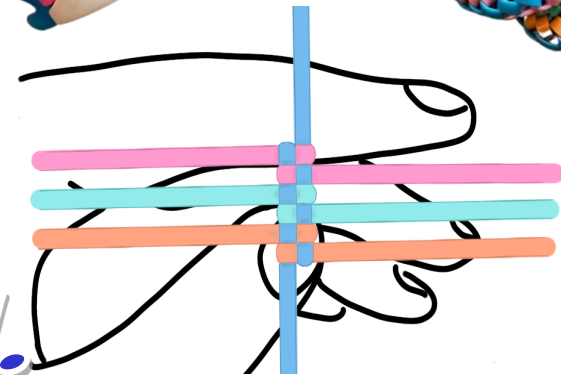

THE CORKSCREW STITCH

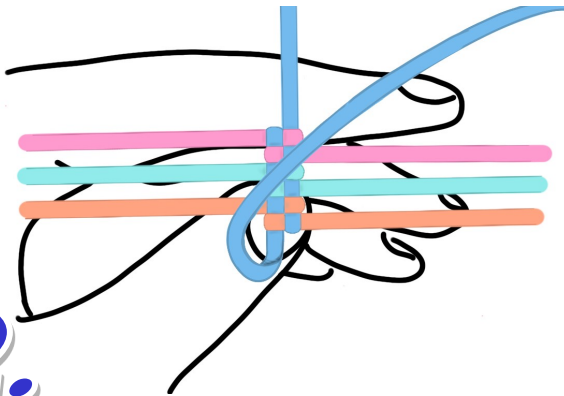

Start by holding your project so that the checkerboard pattern is facing you and vertical.

2.



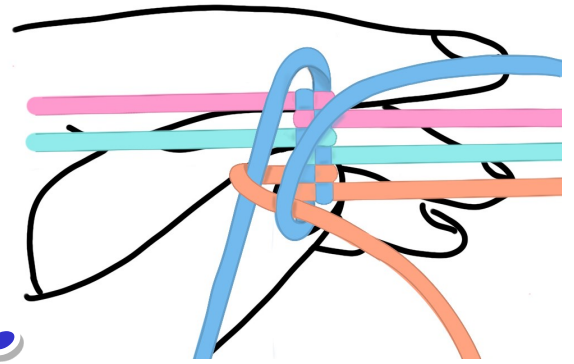
Starting with the blue (long) strand closest to you, on the bottom left hand corner of the project, flip the strand away from you diagonally and to the upper right hand corner of the project.

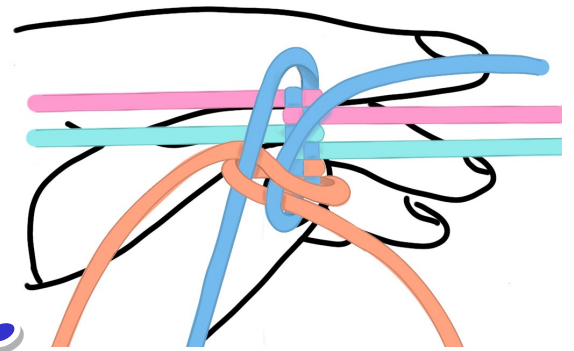
Flip the other end of the blue (long) strand towards you diagonally and to the left of the bottom left hand corner of the project.

4.



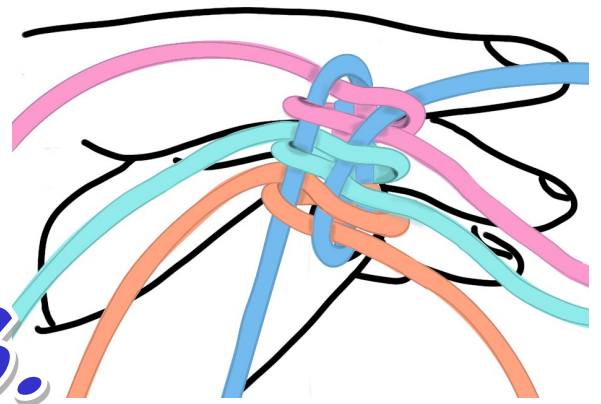
Starting with the left strand closest to you (orange), weave the strand OVER the first blue loop and UNDER the second blue loop.

5.



Weave the right strand closest to you (orange) OVER the first blue loop and UNDER the second blue loop.

6.



Repeat step 4 and step 5 with the green strands and then the pink strands. Be sure to start with the left strand each time.



7.

Gently pull the strands until the checkerboard pattern appears. Note that the checkerboard will be skewed as the project is beginning to spiral. This is expected and the steps remain the same.

Repeat steps 1-6 until your project is the desired length.
