Tornado




Start with the checkerboard pattern facing you. Make the first loop by moving the bottom green strand diagonally upward and between the top green strand and the top blue strand.



Move the top blue strand downward and diagonally to the left.




Create the remaining two loops by moving the bottom blue strand diagonally to the right and the top green strand diagonally to the left.




Weave the left yellow strand to the right and downward by going OVER the first green loop, UNDER the second green loop, OVER the first blue loop and UNDER the second blue loop.



Repeat the process from Step 5 with the yellow strand on the right, weaving it upward and to the left.



Repeat the process from Step 5 with the orange strand on the left, weaving it downward and to the right.



Repeat the process from Step 5 with the orange strand on the right, weaving it upward and to the left.

Tighten the stich until a rounded checkerboard pattern forms.

Repeat Steps 2-8 until the project is the desired length. Finish the project similar to the box stitch by feeding each strand around the one next to it and up through the middle.

Alternating Tornado

To change the direction of the stitch, and achieve a zig zag pattern, make a quad stitch at the point in the project where you would like to change the direction of the stitch/pattern. Starting from Step 1, you will repeat the process; however the loops will be diagonal in the opposite direction.
