





Feed the scoubi strand through 3 pony beads.



Peed the left tail of the scoubi to the right, over the top of the beads, and through the beads back towards the left side of the project. This will create a loop at the top of the project for a lanyard hook.




Feed 5 beads on to the left tail of the scoubi.






Feed the right tail of the scoubi through the same five beads as in Step 3. Gently pull the scoubi strands to tighten the project and align the rows of beads.





Repeat Step 4 with the number of beads and the number of rows shown in the diagram below.



Finish the project by gently tightening the scoubi strands and tie an overhand knot with the tails to secure the project.
